



2014 ICAN™ Talk AAC Summer Camp

- WHAT IS IT?** A 4-day program of interactive, fun-filled activities designed specifically for children who use augmentative and alternative communication (AAC) systems to talk. Our program gives these children opportunities to communicate with other children who use AAC, to develop their language skills and use their devices in new and exciting ways. The camp includes an AAC training seminar for parents. An excursion to a local cultural/historical attraction, swimming, shopping and optional one-on-one consultations with clinical experts in AAC are also offered.
- WHO CAN ATTEND?** Children and young adults (ages 5 to 21 years) who use any kind of AAC system for all or part of their communication. Novices and experienced users are welcome. All campers must be accompanied by one adult. Siblings of comparable age are welcome to accompany the camper (additional fee required). Camp activities are designed for all levels of mobility.
- WHEN?** **July 9 to 12, 2014**
- WHERE?** Crowne Plaza Pittsburgh South, Pittsburgh (6 mi from downtown)
- COST?** Camp fee \$400 (one camper and adult companion)
Accommodations are extra and paid directly to the hotel. Handicapped accessible rooms available.
